KOCHER GETS TWO ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS



Rosemont, PA – Junior captain Heather Kocher (Croydon, PA/Truman) was named to the Pennsylvania Athletic Conference (PAC) All-Conference team as an honorable mention in the outfield as well as being named to the All-Sportsmanship team this spring. The All-Conference team is voted on by coaches from the PAC schools and is based on athletic performance

throughout the season. The All-Sportsmanship team is comprised of a player from each PAC team that has demonstrated outstanding sportsmanship throughout the season. This nomination is done by each school's coach.

Throughout the season, Kocher was solid in center field with a .838 fielding percentage and 17 putouts. At the plate, Kocher led the team both in the batting order and batting average with .288 (19-66). Her on-base percentage was slightly higher at .299.



Her outstanding athletic skills this season were only matched by her strong leadership and sportsmanship. "Heather was always positive and upbeat. She was always respectful to her teammates, coaches, and opponents," assistant coach Jami Hughes says.
